Recommended cleaning procedures

- Promptly remove any excess spills or substances using a non-abrasive absorbing material.
- Clean most soiled surfaces with warm water and a clean microfibre cloth or a soft sponge.
- For stubborn dirt and grease spots, use warm water combined with a liquid dish detergent.
- Other cleaning solutions can be used after testing them in an inconspicuous location.
- If the surface is still not clean, repeat the cleaning steps as necessary.
- Rinse with water and dry the surface with a clean cloth to remove any residue.

Do not use any of the following cleaning agents or utensils

- Abrasive cleaning products such as scouring creams, scorer sponges, steel wool or brushes.
- Polishing agents, waxes, furniture cleaning agents, or bleaching agents.
- Cleaning agents with ammonia, harsh chemicals, strong acids, or highly acidic salts.
- Cleaners containing solvents, vinegar-based cleaners, descaling agents, or cellulose thinners.
- Steam-cleaning equipment.

Precautionary measures

- Avoid cleaning or scrubbing one spot for an extended period.
- Do not perform any cutting work directly on panels; use chopping /cutting boards instead.
- Do not leave soiling or spilled substances on surfaces; wipe it up immediately.
- Do not put hot items such as pots and pans directly on the surface; always use heat protection.
- Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for all cleaning products.
- Always test any cleaning products on an inconspicuous area to ensure it doesn't cause damage.
